

# Cherry Hill Ticket Reservation Update:

June 15, 2020

Dear Guests,

Due to a high demand for ticket reservations and to make our park as accessible as possible to all guests; Cherry Hill has updated its ticket reservation procedures.

Reservations will now be released daily at 5am, one week out. The daily opening of reservations one week out is designed to limit the amount of people reserving tickets at the same time. We are hopeful that with this change our online reservation process will be more available to our guests.

Guests that wish to reserve tickets to Cherry Hill are encouraged to do so early, as reservations will go quickly. We would also request that our Season Pass holders reserve no more than **3 time-slots** each week to ensure that all of our Season Pass guests have an equal opportunity to enjoy our facility. Season Pass holders that are found to be not showing up for their reserved time slots will be contacted by Cherry Hill and may lose their ability to make reservations in the future.

Guests that are camping at Cherry Hill or have a pavilion reservation can continue to reserve tickets during their scheduled stay by contacting the Camp Office once they have made their reservations.

Ticket reservations are non-transferable and void if anyone other than the person reserving the tickets is present to redeem them. Season Pass holders must have a reservation with each pass holders name on their reservations and will be required to show both their season pass and their ticket at the time of entrance.

Thank you to all our loyal guests, we are grateful for your patience as we navigate these changing and uncertain times. We assure you that we are doing everything we can to keep everyone that comes to Cherry Hill safe and healthy as possible. We continue to monitor changing circumstances and will update these policies, if necessary, in the future.
